- 6: WORKER'S COMPENSATION INSURANCE OPTIONS: Representatives from Finance, Human Resources, City Clerk, and Legal have been studying the possibility of self-insuring the City's Workers Compensation Insurance program. Discussion on the issue will be held to ascertain if Council wishes staff to continue investigating the self-insurance option.
- 7: PORTNEUF RIVER LEVEE UPDATE: Randy Ghezzi, Street Operations Superintendent; Deirdre Castillo, Interim City Engineer; and Greg Lanning, Public Works Director; will provide information

on the levee recertification program and request Council guidance on how to proceed with various issues related to the levees.
