- 4: LOWER PORTNEUF VALLEY AQUIFER PRESENTATION: Dr. Glenn Tackray, ISU Geosciences faculty member, will provide information on the Lower Portneuf Valley Aquifer and the need for Bannock County to develop a Ground Water Protection Overlay for the area of the County north of the gap. The presentation will cover the aquifers unique characteristics, and existing threats to water quality from sources such as leaking septic tanks and improperly stored/disposed hazardous materials.
- 5: GATEWAY HABITAT FOR HUMANITY CITY HALL LEASE: Representatives from Gateway Habitat for Humanity will discuss the possibility of leasing office space within City Hall.
