STREET DEPARTMENT FOG SEALING PROJECT
Crews to Work July 26 through August 3, 2010

The City of Pocatello Street Operations Department will begin fog sealing streets Monday, July 26, 2010 and continue through Tuesday August 3, 2010. Parking is restricted in each area beginning at 6:30 a.m. to allow residents time to move vehicles. Crews will work from 7:00 a.m. each day until 5:00 p.m. or until the work is complete. The schedule is below.

Monday and Tuesday, July 26 and 27, 2010, the department will be fog sealing 13th Avenue (Oak to Bonneville), 14th Avenue (Oak to Lewis), 15th Avenue (Oak to Bonneville), Martin Luther King Jr. Memorial Drive (8th to Memorial), Terry Street (Memorial to 19th) and part of Hawthorne Road (Alameda to Quinn). There will be no parking allowed on these streets from 6:30 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. Flaggers will be on site to direct traffic in the construction area, but motorists should expect delays and use alternate routes when possible to avoid travel in these areas.

Wednesday and Thursday, July 28 and 29, 2010, the department will resume fog sealing on Hawthorne Road (Alameda to Quinn), Hurley Drive (Quinn to Bullock), Bullock Street (city limits to dead end), Poleline Road (Yellowstone to Hurley), and Canyon Drive (Fremont to dead end). There will be no parking allowed on these streets from 6:30 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. Flaggers will be on site to direct traffic in the construction area, but motorists should expect delays and use alternate routes when possible to avoid travel in these areas.

Monday and Tuesday, August 2 and 3, 2010, the department will be fog sealing Main Street (Lander to Connor) and Arthur Avenue (Crockett to Whitman). There will be no parking allowed on these streets from 6:30 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. Flaggers will be on site to direct traffic in the construction area, but motorists should expect delays and use alternate routes when possible to avoid travel in these areas.

Fog sealing should be completed Tuesday, August 3, 2010. However, in the event of bad weather or unforeseen problems, the schedule may need to be changed slightly. Crews will finish the work as quickly as possible.
