**MAYOR TO ISSUE THREE PROCLAMATIONS AT CITY COUNCIL MEETING**  
*Local Groups Request Recognition*

Pocatello Mayor Brian Blad will be issuing three proclamations this Thursday, September 15, 2011 at the City Council Meeting scheduled to begin at 6:00 p.m.

The first proclamation recognizes the week of September 17 through September 23, 2011 as Constitution Week. This proclamation recognizes September 17, 2011, as the 224<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the framing of the Constitution of the United States of America. The proclamation is being done at the request of the Wyeth Chapter of the Daughters of the American Revolution.

The second proclaims the week of September 19 to September 24, 2011, to be a Week of *FIRST* (For Inspiration and Recognition of Science and Technology) in Pocatello and urges citizens to do their part to improve the state of science, engineering and robotics education in the community. The proclamation is being done at the request of the LiveWire Robotics Team, comprised of students from Pocatello, Highland and Century High Schools.

The final proclamation recognizes Senior Corps Week for the week of September 19 through September 23, 2011. Citizens are urged to recognize the nearly 450,000 older Americans nationwide who serve their communities as volunteers. Approximately 186 volunteers serve the Pocatello community through the Retired Senior Volunteer Programs and Foster Grandparent program. The proclamation will be accepted by representatives of the Southeastern Idaho Community Action Agency.
