Life-size mannequins represent acceptance of self and others

“We all wear jeans, regardless of the color, label, style, manufacturer, or place of origin. We should feel comfortable in our jeans, and comfortable with each other,” states Utah artist Jamie Reeve on her website dedicated to her traveling art display, The Value in Genes.

The display will be at Pocatello’s Marshall Public Library throughout the month of September. The four life-size mannequins are each wrapped in layers of denim upon which Reeve wrote words and phrases about acceptance and the recognition that we each have value as humans.
