SERGEANT MAURICE “MO” CANFIELD TO RETIRE FROM POLICE DEPARTMENT
Officer to Retire After Nearly 26 Years of Service

On October 19, 2011, Sergeant Maurice “Mo” Canfield will retire from the Pocatello Police Department after nearly 26 years of service in law enforcement. He started his employment with the City of Pocatello as a patrol officer on December 5, 1985.

During Sergeant Canfield’s tenure with the Pocatello Police Department, he worked within the Patrol Division, as a Juvenile Services officer, served as a hostage negotiator and was the first School Resource Officer (SRO) at Century High School. After being promoted to the rank of Sergeant in 2001, he served as the supervisor of the K-9 program and currently serves in the Support Services Division supervising all of the SRO’s. Sergeant Canfield served as a board member of the Bannock Youth Foundation, member of Idaho 6th District Juvenile Justice Council, was a member of the C.A.G.E. gang task force and is a long-time member of Judge Murray’s Community Prevention Group.
