TRAFFIC CONTROL FOR 2011 NIGHT LIGHTS PARADE
Parade Route Changed from Previous Years

Pocatello Police are making preparations for the 2011 Night Lights Parade to be held on Friday, November 25, 2011 at 6:30 p.m. Sergeant Nathan Diekemper advises that the starting/staging point will be the 200 block of South 1st Avenue. The route will be as follows: east on Lewis, north on 3rd Avenue, west on Center Street, south on Union Pacific Avenue, west on Bonneville Street, north on Main Street, east on Wyeth Street, and south on Union Pacific Avenue. The parade will end in the 300 and 400 block of North Union Pacific Avenue.

It is very important that motorists DO NOT park along the parade route. When spectator vehicles are parked on the parade route, it is in violation of the no parking signage. In low light conditions, parked vehicles cause a sight obstruction for participants in the parade and endanger those in attendance. Any vehicles parked on the parade route are subject to enforcement action in accordance with City Code 10.30.080. Pocatello Police requests that citizens park safety, legally and walk to the parade route.

Police Department officials are asking motorists to drive carefully, courteously and cautiously because of the large number of pedestrians in the area.
